

2008 Cabernet Sauvignon

Upon first tasting Bob's Cabernet Sauvignon, one is struck with aromas that speak strongly of a sense of place. Amid dark, dense dried fruit there is a subtle minerality and dusty herb essences, indicative of the 28-year old vines of Snipes Mountain from which the wine is made. On the palate, the fruit is generous without being overly extracted and is complimented by an elegantly restrained touch of toasty oak.
